EXPERIENCE:

FEE AND EXPENSE PRACTICE:

Per diem: \$1,000 per eight hour day (prorated for time over eight hours) for hearing, mediation, travel, study and writing, with a one day minimum for hearing day.

Cancellation: \$1,000 if hearing/mediation is cancelled within 14 days of scheduled date; \$500 if cancelled less than 30 days of scheduled date.

Travel expenses: All actual expenses are billed, IRS rate for use of personal automobile.

Other expenses: Typing, reproduction and postage costs are billed.

NOTE: The arbitrator shall not charge any fee other than the above stated fees. 1/14
