EXPERIENCE:

Have been serving as an Arbitrator since 2002. Considerable grievance and interest arbitration experience in both public and private sector cases covering a broad range of issues, including (but not limited to) contract interpretation, discharge and discipline, work jurisdiction, work rules, pay and benefits, promotion and demotion, attendance and absenteeism, seniority, layoffs, strikes, lockouts, bargaining unit work and management rights.

Prior to becoming an Arbitrator performed labor relations activities as an advocate for both labor and management. Career experience included collective bargaining agreement administration, contract negotiations and labor relations training and education.

FEE AND EXPENSE PRACTICE:

Per Diem: Fee is \$950.00 per day for hearing and for research and preparation of the opinion and award. A hearing is any portion of a day up to eight (8) hours. Time for research and preparation is prorated.

Cancellation Policy: If the scheduled hearing is postponed or cancelled with notice of less than three (3) calendar weeks (or twenty-one days), the per diem rate for each day of the scheduled hearing will be charged.

Expenses: Charges are made for actual cost of necessary and reasonable expenses. Automobile mileage is charged at the applicable IRS expense rate. Travel time is pro-rated per diem.

Note: The Arbitrator shall not charge any fee other than above stated fees.
