**Fees and Expenses:**

Prehearing activity rate is \$190.00 per hour. Per diem fee of \$1,350 is charged for each eight-hour day of travel, hearing (minimum of one day), study and writing. The full per diem is charged for all hearing days. More than one days per diem is charged and prorated for hearing or travel extending beyond eight hours on a hearing day. Study and writing for less than a full day are prorated. Cancellation Fees are equal to one day per diem, if cancelled or postponed within 20 days of the date of hearing. Mileage: \$.58 per mile. All other expenses will be billed.

NOTE: The arbitrator shall not charge any fee other than the above stated fees.
