DIRECTION OF ELECTION

Milwaukee District Council 48, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, having petitioned the Wisconsin Employment Relations Board to conduct an election, pursuant to Section 111.70 of the Wisconsin Statutes, among certain employes of the City of Milwaukee employed in the City Treasurer, and a hearing on said petition having been conducted at Milwaukee, Wisconsin on May 7 and 11, 1962, at the City Hall, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, the full Board being present; and the Board, having considered the evidence and arguments of the parties and being satisfied that a question has arisen concerning representation for said employes of the Municipal Employer;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Board within ninety (90) days from the date of this Directive among all regular employes employed by the City of Milwaukee in the City Treasurer, excluding confidential and supervisory employes and executives who were employed by the City of Milwaukee on February 1, 1963, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employes desire to be represented by Milwaukee District Council 48, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its Local No. 428.

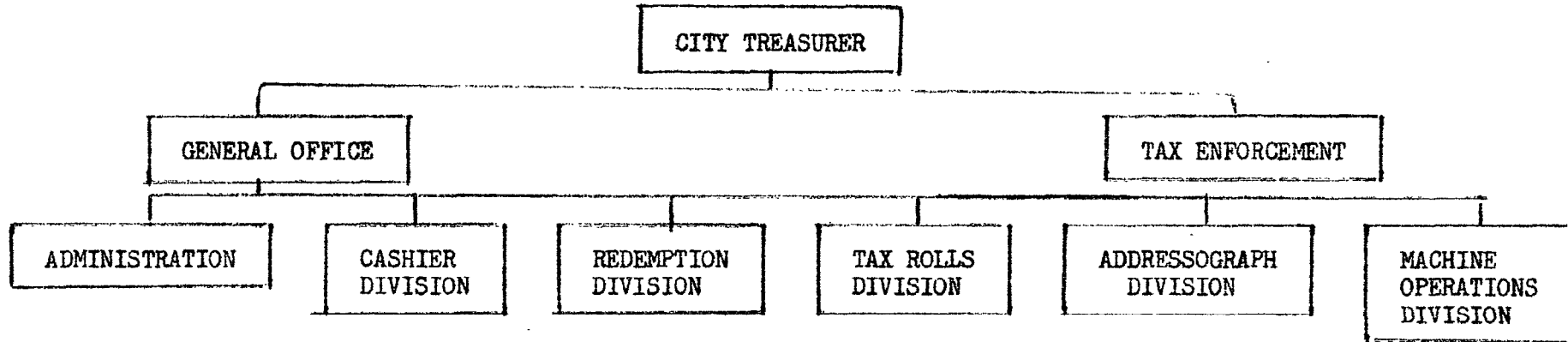

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION

Milwaukee District Council 48 petitioned the Board to conduct a separate election among certain employees employed by the City of Milwaukee in the City Treasurer. This request was contained in the petition filed by said labor organization, which petition also related to other employees of the Municipal Employer. The City Treasurer is a separate department of the Municipal Employer. None of the parties raised an issue concerning the appropriateness of a collective bargaining unit consisting of only employees in the City Treasurer. If a majority of the employees indicate a desire to be represented by Milwaukee District Council 48 and its Local No. 428, employees will have been considered to establish themselves as a separate collective bargaining unit.

The organization of the City Treasurer is as follows:



Eligibles

The parties stipulated that nine (9) positions in the City Treasurer were supervisory and therefore to be excluded from the eligibles participating in the election. The Municipal Employer claimed four (4) additional positions to be supervisory and one (1) additional position to be both supervisory and confidential. The Board has reviewed the evidence with respect to such positions and concludes that the incumbent of only one of the positions in issue performs such supervisory duties so as to exclude him as a supervisor. The following positions and incumbents thereof are to be excluded from the eligibles:
