WHEREAS, on the 7th day of August, 1967, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission ordered fact finding in a municipal employment labor dispute involving the County of Milwaukee and Milwaukee District Council 48, AFSCME AFL-CIO, and its approprate affiliated Local Union 655, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of December, 1967, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued two orders, the first of which delineated the authority of the fact finder, already appointed, in said fact finding proceedings, and the second order ordered fact finding on newly created positions, and

WHEREAS, the said orders of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission were appealed to the Circuit Court in and for Dane County, and the Court, on the 9th day of February, 1968, did remove its order made on January 30, 1968, which order stayed any proceedings by the fact finder;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between the parties by their respective attorneys, that insofar as the first order of December 12, 1967, is concerned, that pending final disposition by this court, this court may remand this matter to the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission with instructions that it remand the matter to the fact finder, already appointed, for fact finding on wages, hours and conditions of employment of the dispute, and that the fact finder is not bound by the first order of December 12, 1967.
