DIRECTION OF ELECTION

District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, having petitioned the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission on October 3, 1969 to conduct an election pursuant to Section 111.70 of the Wisconsin Statutes, among certain employees of Milwaukee County; and a hearing on such petition having been conducted at Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on October 29, 1969, before Robert B. Moberly, Hearing Officer; and the Commission having considered the petition, the evidence and arguments of Counsel, and being satisfied that a question has arisen concerning representation for certain employees of Milwaukee County;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is


DIRECTED


That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Directive in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all County Court reporters employed by Milwaukee County, excluding supervisors, who were employed by the Municipal Employer on November 11, 1969, for the purpose of determining

whether a majority of such employes desire to be represented by District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO for the purposes of conferences and negotiations with Milwaukee County on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment.
