DIRECTION OF ELECTION

District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, having petitioned the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission on October 3, 1969 to conduct an election pursuant to Section 111.70 of the Wisconsin Statutes, among certain employes of Milwaukee County; and a hearing on such petition having been conducted at Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on October 29, 1969, before Robert B. Moberly, Hearing Officer; and the Commission having considered the petition, the evidence and arguments of Counsel, and being satisfied that a question has arisen concerning representation for certain employes of Milwaukee County;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Directive in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all County Court reporters employed by Milwaukee County, excluding supervisors, who were employed by the Municipal Employer on November 11, 1969, for the purpose of determining

whether a majority of such employes desire to be represented by District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO for the purposes of conferences and negotiations with Milwaukee County on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION

District Council 48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, in its petition, required the Commission to conduct an election in a unit consisting of County Court reporters and Circuit Court reporters employed in the Milwaukee County Court House. During the course of the hearing the County objected to the unit desired by the Petitioner, contending that the Circuit Court reporters were not employes of Milwaukee County but were either employes of the State or the individual judges involved. Evidence was adduced with respect to the issue.

Subsequent to the close of the hearing, and prior to any further action by the Commission, the Petitioner requested to amend its petition to reflect the unit desired by it to consist of only the County Court reporters. The County does not object to the amended unit and we are therefore today issuing a Direction of Election among the County Court reporters to determine their intention with respect to representation.
