
ORDER AFFIRMING EXAMINER'S FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSION OF LAW AND ORDER AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Examiner Robert B. Moberly having, on October 30, 1970, issued Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order in the above entitled matter, wherein he dismissed a portion of the complaint filed therein, and on November 17, 1970, the above named Complainant having filed a motion with the Examiner, requesting reconsideration of his decision and at the same time having moved that the Examiner reopen hearing in the matter; and on said date said Complainant also having filed a motion with the Commission requesting an extension of time to file exceptions to the Examiner's decision; and on November 18, 1970, the Commission having issued an Order extending time to the Complainant to file exceptions to the Examiner's decision; and on December 7, 1970, said Examiner having issued an Order denying the motion of the Complainant that the Examiner reopen the hearing; and on January 8, 1971, said Complainant having filed with the Commission exceptions to the Examiner's decision, along with a brief in support thereof; and the Respondent having on March 16, 1971, filed a brief in answer to the Complainant's exceptions; and on April 1, 1971, the Complainant having filed a reply brief in the matter; and further, on March 19, 1971, said Examiner having issued an Order dismissing the remaining portion of the complaint, to which Order no exceptions were filed; and the Commission, having reviewed the entire record, the Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order issued by the Examiner on October 30, 1970, and his Order of Dismissal issued on March 19, 1971, as well as the exceptions filed by the Complainant, and the various briefs with respect to same, and being satisfied that the Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order issued by the Examiner, as well as his Order of Dismissal should be affirmed;


