NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That, pursuant to Section 111.07(5) of the Wisconsin Employment Peace Act, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission hereby adopts the Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued in the above entitled matter as its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order and the Memorandum accompanying same; and, therefore, the Respondent, Liedtke Vliet Super, Inc., shall notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within ten (10) days of the receipt of a copy of this Order as to what steps it has taken to comply therewith.
