MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING
ORDER AMENDING FINDINGS OF FACT

Finding of Fact numbered 11 has been amended in this case to reflect that Wayne Diekrager, School Superintendent, not John Dettinger, District Supervisor of Maintenance, was present at the meeting with Paudler which occurred on January 21, 1971. A similar typographical error occurs in the last sentence of paragraph 3 on page 7 of the Memorandum which accompanied the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order. That sentence should be corrected to read:

Because of the agreement of Paudler and Dettinger on this point and because of Diekrager's later statement, the Examiner is satisfied that Diekrager clearly indicated that he was of the opinion that Paudler and Dettinger were supervisors and not eligible to be represented by the Complainant.

The parties shall have 20 days from the date of this order modifying the Examiner's Findings of Fact in which to file a petition with the Commission pursuant to Section 111.07(5).
