DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having on June 9, 1971, issued an Order in the above entitled matters Determining Appropriate Bargaining Unit and Setting Hearing To Determine Eligibility, as well as other issues which might pertain to an election to be held among the employees in said collective bargaining unit; and said hearing having been conducted on June 1, 1971, Howard S. Bellman, Hearing Officer, being present; and the Commission having reviewed the record and being fully advised in the premises, and being satisfied that questions have arisen concerning representation for certain employees of the Municipal Employer;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Directive among certain employees of Rock County in the collective bargaining unit consisting of<sup>1/</sup> (1) all regular full-time and regular part-time clerical employees in the Courthouse, the Airport, the Beloit County Building, the Guidance Center and Youth Home, the Department of Social Services, the Highway Department, the Sheriff's Department, and (2) all regular full-time and regular part-time airport maintenance employees, and (3) all regular full-time and regular part-time Parks Department employees, but excluding all confidential, supervisory, craft and professional employees and also

<sup>1/</sup> At the June 1, 1971 hearing, the parties agreed to amend the unit specified in Decision Nos. 10352 and 10353 to include in the unit "all regular full-time and regular part-time employees" and to include clerical employees in the Youth Home.

excluding all other employees of Rock County, who were employed by Rock County on June 1, 1971, except such employees as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employees desire to be represented by General Drivers, Dairy Employees and Helpers Local No. 579, affiliated with International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen and Helpers of America, or by Rock County Employees, Local 1077A, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, or by neither of said organizations, for the purposes of conferences and negotiations with Rock County on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment.


