## DIRECTION OF ELECTIONS

Local No. 1362, Calumet County Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, having petitioned the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission to conduct an election pursuant to the Municipal Employment Relations Act, among certain Street Department and Police Department employes in the employ of the City of New Holstein, Wisconsin; and a hearing on said petition having been conducted at the City Hall, New Holstein, Wisconsin, on January 25, 1972, by George R. Fleischli, Hearing Officer; and the Commission having considered the evidence and being satisfied that questions have arisen concerning the representation of certain employes employed in both the Police Department and Street Department of the City of New Holstein;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

# DIRECTED

That elections by secret ballot be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Direction among the employes in the following two collective bargaining units for the purpose of determining whether a majority of the eligible employes voting in each unit desire to be represented by Local No. 1362, Calumet County Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, for the purposes of collective bargaining with the City of New Holstein on wages, hours and conditions of employment:

# UNIT NO. 1

All regular employes of the Street Department of the City of New Holstein, excluding the Street Superintendent, who were employed by the Municipal Employer on February 11, 1972, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause.

# UNIT NO. 2

All regular employes of the Police Department of the City of New Holstein, excluding the Chief, who were employed by the Municipal Employer on February 11, 1972, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause.

# MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTIONS

In its petition the Union requested the Commission to conduct an election in a single unit consisting of all regular employes of the Street Department, excluding the Street Superintendent, and all regular employes of the Police Department, excluding the Chief of Police. During the course of the hearing the parties stipulated to two separate bargaining units; one, consisting of Street Department employes, and the other, consisting of employes in the Police Department. We accept such stipulation on the basis that the Commission believes it would effectuate the policies of the Act not to include law enforcement personnel in units of other city employes.
