AMENDED DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission heretofore and on June 16, 1972, issued a Direction of Election in the above entitled matter; and it having come to the attention of the Commission that the unit set forth in said Direction did not accurately reflect the rationale of the Commission contained in the Memorandum accompanying the Direction of Election in that rather than including the clerical employes and cooks, the unit described in the original Direction would exclude such classifications from the unit; and the Commission being satisfied that the Direction be amended so as to include such classifications in the bargaining unit involved in the instant matter; and, therefore, the Commission issues the following

AMENDED DIRECTION OF ELECTION

That an election by secret ballot be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Directive in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all employes of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department, including clerical employes and cooks, but excluding the Sheriff, the Chief Deputy Sheriff, the Deputy Lieutenant, the Sheriff's Sergeant II's, and all other employes of the Municipal Employer, who were employed by said Municipal Employer on June 16, 1972, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employes desire to be represented by Wisconsin Council of County and Municipal Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, or by Drivers, Salesmen, Warehousemen, Milk Processors, Cannery, DairyEmployees and Helpers Union Local 695, affiliated with International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Chauffeurs, Warehousemen & Helpers of America, or by neither of said organizations, for the purposes of collective bargaining with the Municipal Employer on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment.
