The above-entitled matter having come on for hearing on the 31st day of May, 1973, before the court upon the petition of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission for enforcement of a certain order pursuant to sec. 111.07 (7), Stats., and Robert W. Warren, Attorney General, by Charles D. Hoornstra, Assistant Attorney General, appearing for the petitioner, Robert Kelly, Esq., appearing for International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers Local Union No. 383, and no counsel appearing for the respondent, the respondent appearing by telephone through its president Robert Gile, having heard the positions of the parties and the court being fully advised in the premises,

Now, therefore, on motion of Charles D. Hoornstra, Assistant Attorney General,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the order of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, entered on the 28th day of March, 1973, in the matter of "International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers Local Union No. 383, Complainant, vs. Madison Commercial & Industrial Corp., Respondent, Case I, No. 16273 Ce-1454, Decision No. 11462-3", be, and the same is hereby confirmed and enforced, the court reserving jurisdiction to make such further order or judgment in the premises as may be necessary to give full force and effect to the order of the Commission and the enforcement thereof on the evidence in the record or on the taking of such further evidence as appears to the court to be necessary, the present judgment and decree of the court to be deemed interlocutory as to those matters that may call for or require further action on the part of the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the respondent, Madison Commercial & Industrial Corp., its officers and agents, shall:

"1. Cease and desist from violating Sections 7, 8, 9 and 10 of the collective bargaining agreement in existence between Madison Commercial & Industrial Corp. and International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers Local Union No. 383, by failing to make payment to the Iron Workers Tri-State Welfare Fund, the Iron Workers Mid-America Pension Plan, the Iron Workers Local 383 Vacation Fund, and the Apprentice & Journeyman Retraining Fund of Iron Workers Local 383 of Madison, Wisconsin.

"2. Take the following affirmative action which the court finds will effectuate the policies of the Act:

"(a) Immediately pay to the Iron Workers Tri-State Welfare Fund all amounts due and owing up to March 28, 1973.

"(b) Immediately pay to the Iron Workers Mid-America Pension Fund all amounts due and owing up to March 28, 1973, including the sum of \$425.31 which was the payment due and owing as of November 1, 1972.

"(c) Immediately pay to Iron Workers Local 383 Vacation Fund all amounts due and owing up to March 28, 1973.

"(d) Immediately pay to the Apprentice & Journeyman Retraining Fund of Iron Workers Local 383, Madison, Wisconsin, all amounts due and owing up to March 28, 1973.

"(e) Notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, in writing, within twenty (20) days from the receipt of a copy of this Order as to what action it has taken to comply herewith."
