ORDER MODIFYING FINDINGS OF FACT

Whereas, the Examiner, upon reviewing his Findings of Fact, issued in the above entitled matter on July 23, 1974, and having on same date discovered that he inadvertently omitted a portion of his Findings of Fact; and whereas, pursuant to Section 111.07(6), the Examiner may on his own motion "set aside, modify or change any order, findings or award . . . at any time within 20 days from the date thereof . . ."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That the Findings of Fact in the above entitled matter at paragraph number seven shall be modified to read as follows:

"7. On November 3, 1972 the Principal delivered his response to the grievance; on November 8, 1972 Complainant appealed Mr. Brenegan's reply to the grievance to Mr. Hauer, the Superintendent of Respondent's School District. On November 16, 1972 the Superintendent replied to the Complainant's appeal by affirming the position taken by the Principal Mr. Brenegan, by denying the grievance. On November 21, 1972 the Board of Education affirmed the action of its administrative personnel and denied the grievance. On December 8, 1972 Complainant requested that a Board of Arbitration be established, and with said request Complainant submitted the names of its two appointees to the Board of Arbitration. On January 9, 1973 Respondent appointed its two members to the arbitration panel. That sometime between January 9 and January 23, 1974 the four members of the arbitration panel met in an attempt to resolve the grievance; they were unable to achieve a mutually acceptable resolution of the dispute, That the four members did not appoint a fifth impartial member to the panel. On January 24, 1973, Mr. Hauer advised Complainant that on January 23, 1973, the two Board members to the Arbitration Panel reported to the Board of Education at its meeting; that the Board of Education voted to reaffirm its position denying Complainant's grievance." (Language modifying Finding of Fact No. 7 is underlined.)
