## ORDERED

1. That the hearing in the above entitled matter is postponed until Tuesday, September 25, 1973, at 10:00 a.m., at the Kenosha County Courthouse, Kenosha, Wisconsin.

2. That the Respondent's answer is due on Tuesday, September 18. 1973.
