ORDER DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT

A complaint of prohibited practices having been filed with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by State Association of Career Employees, on August 24, 1973, wherein it alleged that the State of Wisconsin, Department of Administration, had committed prohibited practices within the meaning of the State Employment Labor Relations Act; and the Commission having appointed the undersigned as Examiner to make and issue Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders in the matter; and the Examiner, on August 29, 1973, having scheduled the matter for hearing; and thereafter, the Complainant, on September 5, 1973, having filed a Motion to Dismiss Complaint; and the Examiner having considered said Motion and being convinced that the matter is a "contested case" within the meaning of Section 227.01, Wisconsin Statutes, requiring a public hearing pursuant to Section 227.07, Wisconsin Statutes;

That the Motion to Dismiss Complaint in the above entitled matter be, and the same hereby is, denied. 1/
