#### DIRECTION OF ELECTION

Petition having been filed by Madison Teachers Incorporated with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission requesting that an election to determine bargaining representatives be conducted, pursuant to Section 111.70 of the Wisconsin Statutes, among all regularly employed substitute per diem teachers in the employ of Madison Board of Education Joint School District No. 8, and a hearing on such petition having been conducted at Madison, Wisconsin on May 16, 1974, Kay Hutchison, Hearing Officer, being present, and the Commission being satisfied that a question of representation has arisen with regard to certain employes of Madison Board of Education Joint District No. 8;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

# DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within sixty (60) days of the date of this Directive in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regularly employed substitute per diem teachers (excluding all other employes and supervisors), who are listed on the list of substitute per diem teachers as of June 4, 1974, and who have taught at least thirty (30) or more days in the one-year period immediately preceding said date, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether or not a majority of such employes desire to be represented by Madison Teachers Incorporated for the purposes of collective bargaining with Madison Board of Education Joint School District No. 8 on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment.

### MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The parties stipulated to the conduct of an election among the regularly employed per diem substitute teachers and agreed that employes eligible to vote herein would be those per diem substitutes who had been employed by Madison Board of Education thirty (30) days or more within the 1973-74 school year (one-year period prior to June 4, 1974). It was further agreed that upon direction of an election the Municipal Employer would supply Madison Teachers Incorporated and the Commission with copies of the eligibility list containing those names and addresses of employes who have been employed by the Madison Board of Education thirty (30) days or more during the one-year period preceding June 4, 1974. We deem ten days subsequent to the date of Direction herein to be a reasonable period of time in which to make such list available.
