The above entitled matter having been submitted to the court without oral argument upon the petition by the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission for enforcement of its decision of March 26, 1976; Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, petitioner, appearing by Bronson C. La Follette, Attorney General, and John D. Niemisto, Assistant Attorney General; Joint School District No. 1, City of River Falls, et al., and Paul W. Proescholdt, respondents, appearing by Gaylord, Bye & Rodli, by Keith D. Rodli; Wisconsin Education Association Council, representing the complainants, appearing by Priscilla Ruth MacDougal; and the court having considered the matter upon the record and written arguments of counsel, and having on the 20th day of September, 1977, filed its decision in writing, now, on motion,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the findings of fact and conclusions of law of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, entered on the 26th day of March, 1976, in the matter of "Gail Andersen, Marjorie Bierbrauer, Alice Early, Jennifer Haskins, Beth Hawkins, Margaret Kitze, Rosemary Lynch, Elenore Richards, Jane Schobert, Joan Sveen and the River Falls Education Association, complainants, vs. Joint School District No. 1, City of River Falls, et al. and Paul W. Proescholdt, respondents, Case II, No. 17983 MP-367, Decision No. 12754-B" be, and the same hereby is confirmed and the matter remanded to the commission for the purpose of reviewing its order as to the individuals involved as to their employment following the hearing and to make amendments thereto if necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, the court reserving jurisdiction to make such further order or judgment in the premises as may be necessary to give full force and effect to the said order of the commission and the enforcement thereof on the evidence in the record or on the taking of such further evidence by the commission on remand, the present order and judgment of the court to otherwise be deemed final.
