

The above entitled matter having come on for hearing before the court upon the petition of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission for enforcement of its supplemental findings of fact, conclusions of law and order issued January 17, 1979, following remand pursuant to the court's original order and judgment dated January 3, 1978, which affirmed and enforced the decision of the Commission but remanded the matter to the Commission for the purpose of reviewing its order with respect to the individual complainants involved as to their employment following the hearing before the examiner; petitioner, Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, appearing by Bronson C. La Follette, Attorney General, and John D. Niemisto, Assistant Attorney General; Joint School District No. 1, City of River Falls, et al., and Paul W. Proescholdt, respondents, appearing by Gaylord, Bye and Rodli, by Keith D. Rodli; Wisconsin Education Association, representing the

complainants before the Commission, appearing by Priscilla Ruth Mac Dougall; and the court having considered the matter upon the record and written and oral arguments of counsel, and having on the 17th day of March, 1980, filed its decision in writing now, on motion,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the supplemental findings of fact, conclusions of law and order of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, entered on January 17, 1979, in the above entitled matter are hereby confirmed, the court reserving jurisdiction to make such further order or judgment in the premises as may be necessary to give full force and effect to the said order of the Commission and the enforcement thereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the respondent Joint School District No. 1, City of River Falls, et al., its officers and agents, shall immediately:

1. Cease and desist from refusing to tender Gail Anderson an eighty percent teaching contract.

2. Take the following affirmative action which the court finds will effectuate the policies of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Act:

- a. Immediately offer to Gail Anderson an eighty percent teaching contract.


- b. Pay to Gail Anderson the amount of money that she would have received had the District offered to her an eighty percent teaching contract for the 1974-75 school year up to and including the 1979-80 school year.

c. Pay to Eleanor Richards the amount of money that she would have received had the District offered to her a sixty percent teaching contract for the 1974-75 school year. Said sum totals \$6,614.58.

3. Notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission and this court in writing, within twenty (20) days following the date of this order and judgment as to what steps have been taken to comply herewith.
