DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The above named Petitioner having filed a petition with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission requesting that the Commission conduct an election pursuant to Section 111.70 of the Wisconsin Statutes, among certain employes of the Fox Valley Technical Institute; and a hearing on said petition having been conducted on June 27, 1974, at Appleton, Wisconsin, Thomas L. Yaeger, Hearing Officer, having been present; and during a prehearing discussion the parties having stipulated to the unit appropriate for collective bargaining and to the employes eligible to vote within said unit, and the Commission having considered the evidence and being satisfied that a question of representation has arisen concerning certain employes of the Municipal Employer;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

-1-

That an election by secret ballot be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, within 60 days from the date of this Directive, in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all Educational Aides, including all regular fulltime and regular part-time aides working one-half time or more in the day school in the employ of Fox Valley Technical Institute, but excluding supervisory, technical, managerial, confidential and all other employes, who were employed by said Municipal Employer on June 27, 1974, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employes desire to be represented by Fox Valley Technical Institute Association of Educational Aides, for the purposes of collective bargaining with the Municipal Employer on questions of wage, hours and conditions of employment.
