The above entitled matter having been submitted to the court without argument upon the petition of the City of Wauwatosa for review of a declaratory ruling of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission which found that the City of Wauwatosa does have a duty to bargain collectively with Wauwatosa Fire Fighters Local 1923, IAFF, with respect to their proposal that firefighters be relieved of performing switchboard duties; City of Wauwatosa, petitioner, appearing by Harold D. Gehrke, City Attorney; Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, respondent, appearing by Bronson C. La Follette, Attorney General, and Charles D. Hoornstra, Assistant Attorney General; and the court having considered the matter upon the record, and having, on the 29th day of March, 1976, filed its decision in writing, now, upon motion of Charles D.
