### DIRECTION OF ELECTION

District Council 40, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, having petitioned the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission to conduct an election pursuant to Section 111.70 of the Wisconsin Statutes among certain employes of Menomonee Falls Joint School District No. 1; and hearing on such petition having been conducted on March 25, 1975 at Milwaukee, Wisconsin by Stanley H. Michelstetter II, Hearing Officer, during which Menomonee Falls Secretarial Association was permitted to intervene on the basis that it is the present representative of the employes involved but that it no longer desired to represent the employes involved; and thereafter the Petitioner and the Municipal Employer having reached agreement on all issues and having executed a stipulation for election;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

#### DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within sixty (60) days from the date of this Directive in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and all regular part-time clerical employes of Menomonee Falls Joint School District No. 1, but excluding professional, supervisory, managerial, confidential, and executive employes, who were employed by the Municipal Employer on April 2, 1975, except such employes as may quit their employment or are terminated for cause prior to the election, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employes desire to be represented by District Council 40, AFSCNE, AFL-CIO, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Menomonee Falls Joint School District No. 1 on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment or by no labor organization.

## MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION

In Menomonee Falls Joint School District No. 1 (11669) 3/73, we directed an election in a unit consisting of "all clerical employes of Menomonee Falls Joint School District No. 1, but excluding professional, supervisory, managerial, and executive employes" in which the Intervenor was selected as the representative of that unit. Intervenor and the Municipal Employer thereafter agreed to exclude substitute clericals and work-study students. The parties by their stipulation have agreed to restate the unit to exclude those employes. We find no inconsistency with our policy in that stipulation.
