

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING
ORDER CLARIFYING BARGAINING UNIT

The Petitioner, on April 30, 1964, a/ was certified as the collective bargaining representative of the employes in the bargaining unit described in the Order. In the Memorandum attached to the Direction leading to the election, which resulted in said certification, pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, the Commission excluded from the unit the Public Health Laboratory Superintendent and the Bacteriologist III as supervisors. The classifications of Virologist V and Chemist V did not exist at the time. During the course of the hearing on the instant petition the parties stipulated that the duties performed by the individuals occupying such positions, were supervisory in nature, and the Commission is satisfied that the individuals occupying said classifications are supervisors, and, therefore, we have excluded them from the bargaining unit.
