ORDER CLARIFYING BARGAINING UNIT

Association of Scientific Personnel having filed a petition with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission wherein it requested the Commission to determine whether the classifications of Virologist V (occupying the title of Chief Virologist) and Chemist V (occupying the title of Chief Chemist) employed by the City of Milwaukee should be excluded from the collective bargaining unit consisting of Scientific Personnel employed in the Bureau of Laboratories in the Health Department of the City of Milwaukee, excluding all other employees, confidential employees, supervisors and executives; and hearing on such petition having been held at Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on February 26, 1975, before Stanley H. Michelstetter II, a member of the Commission's staff; and during the course of the hearing the parties having stipulated as to the duties of the Virologist V and the Chemist V; and the Commission being satisfied that the duties performed by the individuals occupying such classifications are supervisory in nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That the classification of Virologist V (occupying the title of Chief Virologist) and Chemist V (occupying the title of Chief Chemist) shall be, and hereby are, excluded from the collective bargaining unit described above.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING
ORDER CLARIFYING BARGAINING UNIT

The Petitioner, on April 30, 1964, a/ was certified as the collective bargaining representative of the employees in the bargaining unit described in the Order. In the Memorandum attached to the Direction leading to the election, which resulted in said certification, pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, the Commission excluded from the unit the Public Health Laboratory Superintendent and the Bacteriologist III as supervisors. The classifications of Virologist V and Chemist V did not exist at the time. During the course of the hearing on the instant petition the parties stipulated that the duties performed by the individuals occupying such positions, were supervisory in nature, and the Commission is satisfied that the individuals occupying said classifications are supervisors, and, therefore, we have excluded them from the bargaining unit.
