The Commission having heretofore, on August 31, 1978, issued its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order Clarifying Bargaining Unit and Amending Certification in the above-entitled proceeding; and thereafter, it having been brought to the Commission's attention that paragraph 2 of our order contained an error in that it inadvertently omitted the words "teachers on leave of absence, and teachers under temporary contract"; and the Commission being satisfied that paragraph 2 of its order be amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

That paragraph 2 of our order in the above-entitled proceeding be amended to read as follows:

"2. That the positions of Project Assistants Principal, Investigators, Researchers and Photographer-Technician shall be, and hereby are included in the unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time certified classroom teachers in the employ of Madison Metropolitan School District; and therefore the existing professional bargaining unit presently represented by Madison Teachers, Inc., is hereby amended to read as follows:

'all regular full-time and regular part-time teaching and other related professional personnel who are employed in a professional capacity to work with students and teachers, employed by the District including psychologists, psychomotrists, social workers, attendants and visitation workers, work experience coordinator, remedial reading teacher, University Hospital teachers, trainable group teachers, librarians, cataloger, educational reference librarian, text librarian, Title I coordinator, guidance counselors, teaching assistant principals (except at Sunnyside School), teachers on leave of absence, and teachers under temporary contract, project assistants, principal investigators, researchers and photographer technician, but excluding supervisor - cataloging and processing, on call

substitute teachers, interns, and all other employes,
principals, supervisors and administrators."
