The petitioners applied to the respondents for the establishment of an additional statewide gargaining unit consisting of conservation wardens under the provisions of Sec. 111.81(3)(am), Wis. Stats. The respondents declined and dismissed the petition with an accompanying memorandum.

A review of the record in this matter and study of the issues raised in the parties' briefs leads the Court to the same conclusion as was reached by the respondent. The Commission's memoranda succinctly states the rationale and the Court cannot improve upon it.

The order of the Commission is affirmed. Counsel may draft an appropriate order.
