ORDER AMENDING FINDING OF FACT

Michelstetter II, a member of its staff, to act as Examiner to make and issue findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders as provided in Sec. 111.07 (5), Stats., and the Examiner having heretofore and on May 2, 1977 issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in said matter; and the Examiner being satisfied that Finding of Fact 10 thereof should be amended

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That Finding of Fact 10 of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued May 2, 1977 in the above-entitled matter be amended to read as follows:

"10. That after June 25th Michael performed unit work in Complainant's jurisdiction for only four work days commencing August 22nd and including August 25th; that Mark did so only on June 26th; and that Urban did so for not more than four days; that at no time after June 25th did Respondent make any contribution to the Southern Wisconsin Apprenticeship and Journeyman Training Fund pursuant to Article IX of the parties' collective bargaining agreement."
