NOW, therefore, on motion of John D. Niemisto, Assistant Attorney General,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the order of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, entered on the 19th day of July, 1976, in the matter of "Barron County Highway Department Employees Local Union No. 518, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Complainant, vs. Barron County (Highway Department), Respondent, Case XI, No. 19643, MP-518, Decision No. 14025-B" be, and the same hereby is confirmed and enforced, the court reserving jurisdiction to make such further order or judgment in the premises as may be necessary to give full force and effect to the order of the Commission and the enforcement thereof on the evidence in the record or on the taking of such further evidence as appears to the court to be necessary, the present judgment and decree of the court to be deemed interlocutory as to those matters that may call for or require further action on the part of the court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the respondent, Barron County Highway Department, and its officers and agents, shall immediately:

1. Cease and desist from:

- a. Failing and refusing to recognize and accept as conclusive the arbitration award issued on August 22, 1975 whereby it was determined by the Arbitrator that Barbara Weisser should have served a three-month rather than a 12-month probationary period, and that payment of \$300 be made to her.
- 2. Take the following affirmative action which will effectuate the policies of the Municipal Employment Relations Act:
- a. Immediately comply with the arbitration award issued on August 22, 1975, by paying Barbara Weisser \$300 as directed in said award.
- b. Notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in writing, within twenty (20) days from the receipt of notice of entry of this Order and Judgment as to what steps have been taken to comply herewith.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that no costs shall be awarded in this matter.
