The Respondent Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission pursuant to the Court's Order dated September 2, 1977, having by supplemental return filed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law dated September 9, 1977, together with a Memorandum entitled "Memorandum Accompanying Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law"; and it appearing from the facts recited in said Memorandum that petitioner City of Oak Creek at the hearing held by the respondent Commission on December 23, 1975, presented no evidence or argument that the three captains among the firefighters employed by it were managerial employees, executive employees, confidential employees, independent contractors, or should otherwise be excluded from the bargaining unit; and the Court therefore having concluded that the respondent Commission was not required in its Findings of Fact to make any finding with respect to whether the three captains, or any of them, were managerial employees, executive employees, or confidential employees;

It is Ordered that the Judgment entered in the above entitled review proceeding on July 22, 1977, and which was vacated by the Court's Order dated September 2, 1977, be, and the same hereby is, reinstated.
