JUDGMENT CONFIRMING AND  
ENFORCING COMMISSION ORDER

The above entitled proceeding having come on for hearing before the court, the Honorable Ronald D. Keberle, presiding, on February 28, 1977, upon the petition of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission for enforcement of its order dated June 17, 1976; and

The commission having appeared by David C. Rice, Assistant Attorney General, the respondent, American Structural Systems, Inc., having appeared by Ray Thums, and the International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, Local Union No. 383, having appeared by William Haus; and

The court having issued its opinion on March 22, 1977, affirming the order of the commission,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the order of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, entered on the 17th day of June, 1976, in the matter entitled "International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, Local Union No. 383 vs. American Structural Systems, Inc., Case I, No. 20063 Ce-1656, Decision No. 14286-C" be, and the same hereby is, confirmed and enforced.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that respondent, American Structural Systems, Inc., shall immediately:

1. Cease and desist from violating the terms of the parties' 1975-1979 collective bargaining agreement.
2. Take the following affirmative action which will effectuate the purposes of the Wisconsin Employment Peace Act:
  - (a) In accordance with the memorandum accompanying the commission's order, make whole those individuals on the referral list maintained by the International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers Local Union No. 383, who would have performed a total of 600 hours of work on the Martell project.
  - (b) Make payments in accordance with the terms of the parties' 1975-1979 collective bargaining agreement to the Health and Welfare Pension, Vacation and Apprentice Training Funds on behalf of those individuals who would have performed a total of 600 hours of work on the Martell project under the terms of the collective bargaining agreement.
  - (c) Notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in writing within twenty (20) days following the date of this judgment as to what steps have been taken to comply herewith.
