ORDER AFFIRMING EXAMINER'S FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSION OF LAW AND ORDER

Examiner Peter G. Davis having, on October 20, 1976, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above entitled proceeding, 1/ wherein the above named Respondent was found to have violated the terms of a collective bargaining agreement and committed a prohibited practice within the meaning of Section 111.70(3)(a)5 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and wherein the Respondent was ordered to cease and desist therefrom and to take certain affirmative action with respect thereto; and the Examiner thereafter having, on November 3, 1976, issued an Order setting aside said Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order pending modification of same 2/ and subsequently, on November 18, 1976, having issued an Order reinstating his Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order previously issued as modified therein; 3/ and no petition for review of said Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order, as modified, having been filed within the statutory period set forth in Section 111.07(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That, pursuant to Section 111.07(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order, as modified, issued in the above entitled matter, hereby are considered as the Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order, and therefore, the Respondent, Village of Grafton (Police Department), shall notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within ten (10) days of the date of this Order as to what steps it has taken to comply therewith.
