ORDER AFFIRMING EXAMINER'S FINDINGS  
OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

Examiner Stanley H. Michelstetter II having, on December 14, 1976, issued his findings of fact, conclusions of law and order with accompanying memorandum in the above-entitled proceeding wherein the above named respondent was found to have committed and was committing unfair labor practices within the meaning of sec. 111.06(1)(c) and 111.06(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Employment Peace Act by discharging employes John Voith and John Stackpole, and wherein the respondent was ordered to cease and desist therefrom and to take certain affirmative action with respect thereto; and said examiner having, on December 17, 1976, issued an order modifying finding of fact No. 17 but otherwise allowing his findings of fact, conclusions of law and order to remain unchanged; and the respondent on January 5, 1977, having filed a petition requesting the commission to review the decision of the examiner pursuant to Section 111.07(5) of the Wisconsin Employment Peace Act because of the respondent's dissatisfaction with said findings and order; and the commission having reviewed the record presented and being satisfied that the findings of fact, conclusions of law and order with accompanying memorandum issued by the examiner as modified should be affirmed;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That pursuant to sec. 111.07(5) of the Wisconsin Employment Peace Act, the examiner's findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, as modified, issued in the above-entitled matter hereby are considered as the commission's findings of fact, conclusions of law and order, and, therefore, the respondent, Hi Fi Salon, Incorporated d/b/a Soundstage shall notify the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within ten (10) days of the receipt of the date of this order as to what steps it has taken to comply therewith.
