## LEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER DENYING IN PART MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS IN THE ALTERNATIVE TO DISMISS THE PROCEEDINGS AND POSTPONING HEARING WITH RESPECT TO THE COMPLAINTS OF TURNER AND BOLES PENDING ARGUMENT ON SAID MOTION
