Carole Turner, Barbara L. Boles, and Kathy Casselman having filed separate unfair labor practice complaints with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission alleging that Theodore P. Odell, Quercus Alba, Inc., had committed certain unfair labor practices; and the foregoing complaints having been consolidated for hearing; and the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having appointed Peter G. Davis, a member of its staff, to act as Hearing Examiner in the matter, and a hearing in the matter having been scheduled for July 9, 1976; and Theodore P. Odell, Quercus Alba, Inc., having thereafter filed a motion to stay proceedings and in the alternative to dismiss the complaints; and the Examiner having considered the matter,

ORDERED

1. That the motion to stay proceedings and in the alternative to dismiss the complaint is denied with respect to the complaint of Kathy Casselman and that a hearing on said matter will therefore be held as scheduled on July 9, 1976.

Boles is hereby postponed until July 27, 1976, at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission's offices in Madison, Wisconsin, to allow said individual complainants an opportunity to submit arguments with respect to the motion to stay proceedings and in the alternative to dismiss the complaint, said argument to be filed by July 15, 1976.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER DENYING IN PART MOTION TO  
STAY PROCEEDINGS IN THE ALTERNATIVE TO DISMISS THE PROCEEDINGS  
AND POSTPONING HEARING WITH RESPECT TO THE COMPLAINTS OF TURNER  
AND BOLES PENDING ARGUMENT ON SAID MOTION

Inasmuch as the motion filed by Theodore P. Odell, Quercus Alba, Inc., is premised upon its contention that Carole Turner and Barbara L. Boles have filed charges with the National Labor Relations Board which parallel the allegations contained in the complaints filed with the Commission, and said contention having been supported by exhibits indicating same, the Examiner has postponed the hearing with respect to the complaints filed by these two individuals to allow for argument on said motion. However, there being no indication in said motion or supporting affidavits and exhibits that Kathy Casselman has filed a charge with the National Labor Relations Board, the Examiner has denied the motion with respect to said individual complaint.
