NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That, pursuant to Section 111.07(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, issued in the above-entitled matter, hereby are affirmed and same shall be considered the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, and, therefore, the Respondents, Madison Metropolitan School District, Board of Education,
