ORDER CONSOLIDATING CASES FOR PURPOSES OF HEARING AND DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS

Gary Glover and Doug Geske, hereinafter Complainants, having on December 7, 1976, filed a complaint of unfair labor practices against Reuben Kamm, Business Agent, Local 921, Amalgamated Clothing Workers of America, Case II; on December 7, 1976, Complainants having filed a Complaint of unfair labor practices against Norwood Mills, Inc., Case III; the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having appointed Sherwood Malamud, Examiner in both Cases II and III; on December 27, 1976, Respondent Reuben Kamm by his counsel having filed a "Motion to Dismiss Complaint and Order Directing Hearing"; and since the Complaints in Case II and Case III state allegations which arise from the same set of facts, therefore, the Examiner issues the following;

ORDER

1. That the Complaints in Case II and Case III scheduled for hearing on January 14, 1977, be, and the same hereby are, consolidated for purposes of hearing.
2. That the period for filing answers to the Complaints is hereby extended from January 5, 1977, to January 12, 1977.
3. That at 9:30 a.m. on January 14, 1977, prior to the commencement of the hearing, a pre-hearing conference is hereby scheduled pursuant to sec. 227.07(4)(a) of the Wisconsin Administration Procedure Act, as amended, for the purpose of establishing procedures for the hearing of Case II and Case III.

FOR PURPOSES OF HEARING AND DENYING MOTION TO DISMISS




