NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.

Examiner Thomas L. Yaeger having, on August 2, 1979, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled proceeding, wherein the above-named Respondent was found not to have committed any prohibited practices within the meaning of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; and thereafter and on August 21, 1979, said Examiner having, pursuant to a motion filed by the Complainant, issued an Order granting the motion to reconsider and further set aside his Order of August 2, 1979; and thereafter, and on March 10, 1980, said Examiner having issued his Order Amending Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, wherein the above-named Respondent was found to have committed, and was committing, a prohibited practice within the meaning of Section 111.70(3)(a)4 and 1 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and wherein the Respondent was ordered to cease and desist therefrom and to take certain affirmative action with respect thereto; and no petition for review of said Amended Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, having been filed within the twenty day statutory period set forth in Section 111.07(5), Stats.; and no intervening order by the Examiner or the Commission having been issued within said statutory period;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission issues the following

NOTICE




