ORDER DISMISSING PETITION AND
SETTING ASIDE PREVIOUS CERTIFICATION

Lutheran Children's Friend Society of Wisconsin having filed a petition with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission requesting that an election be conducted among all of its employees employed in residential treatment services, including those in housekeeping, maintenance, dietary and direct patient services employees, but excluding managerial, supervisors, confidential employees, professional social workers, theological teachers and transient help, to determine whether said employees desired to continue to be represented by Milwaukee District Council #48, AFSCME, AFL-CIO and its affiliated Local #1954, which organization, following an election conducted by the Commission, had been certified on September 20, 1976 as the collective bargaining representative for the employees in the above unit; and prior to the conduct of the hearing on the instant petition, said labor organization, having advised the Commission, by letter dated September 21, 1977, that it is no longer interested in representing the employees involved; and therefore the Commission being satisfied that a question of representation does not exist among the employees involved;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. That the petition filed in the instant matter be, and the same hereby is, dismissed.

2. That the Certification of Representatives issued by the Commission on September 20, 1976, wherein Milwaukee District Council






MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER DISMISSING PETITION
AND SETTING ASIDE PREVIOUS CERTIFICATION


Since the Union no longer claims to represent the employees involved, no question of representation exists, and therefore it is unnecessary to conduct an election herein and therefore, the Commission has dismissed the petition. Because of the Union's disclaimer of representation, the Commission will not process a petition filed by the Union seeking to represent the same employees one year from the date hereof. As a result of the Union's disclaimer of representation, the Commission is also setting aside the Certification of Representatives issued on September 20, 1976 wherein the Union was certified as the bargaining representative of the employees herein.
