NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSION OF
LAW AND ORDER CLARIFYING BARGAINING UNIT

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having, on March 13, 1980, issued an Order 1/ appointing Christopher Honeyman an Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 227.09(3)(c), Stats., for the purpose of conducting a hearing and issuing a proposed decision in the instant matter in accordance with the procedure contained in Section 227.09(2), Stats.; and the Commission having further provided in said Order that if neither party to the proceeding filed written objections to the Examiner's proposed decision and the Commission did not act to set aside said proposed decision within twenty days, the proposed decision would be deemed to be the final decision of the Commission; and Examiner Honeyman having, on May 19, 1980, issued his proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order Clarifying Bargaining Unit, with Accompanying Memorandum, pursuant to said Order; and no written objections having been filed and no Commission Order setting aside said proposed decision having been issued within the period provided;


