NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSION
OF LAW AND ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.

Examiner Stanley H. Michelstetter II having, on April 25, 1978, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled proceeding, wherein the above-named Respondent was found to have committed, and was committing, a prohibited practice within the meaning of Section 111.70(3)(a)5 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and wherein the Respondent was ordered to cease and desist therefrom and to take certain affirmative action with respect thereto; and no petition for review of said Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, having been filed within the twenty day statutory period set forth in Section 111.07(5), Stats.; and no intervening order by the Examiner or the Commission having been issued within said statutory period;
