NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDERS PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.

Examiner Michael F. Rothstein having, on August 7, 1980, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled proceeding, wherein the above-named Respondent Bloomer Professional Educators Association was found to have committed, and was committing, prohibited practices within the meaning of Section 111.70(3)(b)1 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and wherein said Respondent Association was ordered to cease and desist therefrom and to take certain affirmative action with respect thereto; and no petition for review of said Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders, with Accompanying Memorandum, having been filed within the twenty day statutory period set forth in Section 111.07(5), Stats.; and no intervening order by the Examiner or the Commission having been issued within said statutory period;
