ORDER DENYING MOTION TO MAKE COMPLAINT MORE DEFINITE AND CERTAIN;
AND GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER
COMPLAINT AND TO RESCHEDULE HEARING

Franklin Education Association, herein Complainant, having filed a prohibited practice complaint with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, herein Commission, wherein it alleged that the School Board of Franklin School District No. 5, and Harry Guzniczak, Superintendent, herein Respondents, committed certain prohibited practices, and the Commission having appointed Stephen Pieroni, a member of the Commission's staff, to act as Examiner in the matter; and thereafter Respondents, by counsel, having filed motions to make complaint more definite and certain, and for extension of time to answer, and to postpone hearing; and the Complainant's agreeing to a postponement of hearing and filing a response to the motion to make more definite and certain; and the Examiner having considered the matter;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. That the motion to make the complaint more definite and certain is denied.
2. That the Respondents shall serve an answer upon the Examiner and the parties on or before the date designated for the hearing herein.
3. That a hearing shall be rescheduled for Friday, June 16, 1978, and, if necessary, Monday, June 19, 1978, at 10:30 a.m. in the City Hall, 9229 West Loomis Road, Franklin, Wisconsin.

EXTENSION OF TIME TO ANSWER COMPLAINT AND TO RESCHEDULE HEARING


