AMENDED DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, heretofore and on June 2, 1978, having issued Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Direction of Election in the above entitled matter; and the Commission, in preparing for the conduct of the election, having discovered that the Direction, as issued, does not properly set forth the voting requirement for the selection of the bargaining representative, and further, does not set forth that the eligible employes also have the opportunity to cast a ballot against any representation; therefore the Commission being satisfied that the Direction of Election should be amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

That the Direction of Election previously issued herein be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty days of the date of this directive in the appropriate collective bargaining unit consisting of all employes in the City of Green Bay Public Works Department in the Street Division, Sanitation Division and Sewer Division, excluding seasonal, supervisory, managerial, confidential, office and clerical employes, who were employed by the Municipal Employer on April 27, 1978, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employes voting desire to be represented by the Green Bay Public Works Department Employees Association, or Teamsters Local No. 75, or Wisconsin Council of County and Municipal Employees, Council 40, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, or by none of said organizations, for the purposes of collective bargaining with the City of Green Bay with respect to wages, hours and conditions of employment.
