ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR REVIEW AND
NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSION OF LAW AND ORDER PURSUANT TO
SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.

Examiner Stanley H. Michelstetter II having, on March 4, 1980, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusion of Law and Order 1/ in the above-entitled matter, wherein the above-named Respondent, Williams Bay Public Schools, was found not to have committed any prohibited practices within the meaning of Section 111.70(3)(a)5 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and wherein said Examiner dismissed said complaint; and the Complainant, Williams Bay Education Association having, on March 24, 1980, timely filed a petition requesting the Commission to review said decision, pursuant to the provisions of Section 111.07(5), Wis. 
NOW, THEREFORE, it is


ORDERED
