DIRECTION OF ELECTIONS

The Petitioner and the Municipal Employer named above having filed a stipulation with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, requesting the Commission to conduct elections among certain employees of the above named Municipal Employer, pursuant to Section 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; 1/

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That elections by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within thirty (30) days from the date of this Directive in the following voting groups for the following stated purposes:

Voting Group No. 1

All regular full-time and regular part-time employees of the Pepin County Department of Social Services, the Pepin County Nurses Department, and the Pepin County Office of Aging, conditionally excluding professional employees, and fully excluding managerial, supervisory and confidential employees, who were employed on June 6, 1979, except such employees as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of such employees voting desire to be represented by Wisconsin Council of County and Municipal Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, for the purposes of collective bargaining with Pepin County on questions of wages, hours and conditions of employment.

Voting Group No. 2

All regular full-time and regular part-time professional social workers employed by the Pepin County Department of Social Services, excluding supervisory and confidential employees, who were employed on June 6, 1979, except such employees as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining (1) whether a majority of the employees in said voting group
