ORDER SETTING ASIDE CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF ELECTIONS

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, following an election conducted by it, on July 30, 1979, certified the Waushara County Employees Association (Social Services, 51.42, and Health Services) as the collective bargaining representative for all regular full-time and regular part-time employes of Waushara County employed in the Social Service, 51.42, and Health Services Departments, including professional employes, but excluding supervisory, confidential and managerial employes; and thereafter and on July 17, 1980, representatives of said Association, in writing, advised the Commission that it desired that the Commission decertify said Association as the collective bargaining representative of the employes in the employ of Waushara County in the unit noted above; and the Commission being fully advised in the premises, makes and issues the following

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Certification of Results of Elections previously issued by the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in the above-entitled matter be, and the same hereby is, set aside.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER SETTING ASIDE CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF ELECTIONS

The Waushara County Employees Association (Social Services, 51.42, and Health Services), following an election conducted by the Commission, was certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of both professional and non-professional employes employed in the Social Service, 51.42 and Health Services Departments of Waushara County. On July 17, 1980, the Commission received a communication from the representatives of said Association, indicating that it no longer desired to remain the collective bargaining representative of the professional and nonprofessional employes employed in the unit previously certified. Thereafter and on August 22, 1980, representatives of Waushara County and Wisconsin Council of County and Municipal Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO executed a stipulation requesting that a representation election be conducted among the non-professional and professional employes employed by the County in its Department of Social Services and in its 51.42 Said election was conducted on September 16, 1980, resulting Board. in the issuance of a Certification of Results of Elections on September 26, 1980, wherein AFSCME was certified as the bargaining representative of all regular full-time and regular part-time nonprofessional and professional employes of the Waushara County Department of Social Services and 51.42 Board, excluding supervisory, managerial and confidential employes.

As a result of the election in September 1980, the professional and non-professional employes of Waushara County, who are employed in its Health Services Department are not presently represented for the purposes of collective bargaining. Since the communication received July 17, 1980 from the Waushara County Employees Association indicated that it desired to be decertified as the bargaining representative, it is obvious that said Association no longer represents the employees in the Health Services Department of the County, and, therefore, we are today setting aside the original Certification.
