NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF
LAW AND ORDER CLARIFYING BARGAINING UNIT

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having, on August 21, 1979, issued an Order ^{1/} appointing Douglas V. Knudson as Examiner, pursuant to the provisions of Section 227.09, Stats., for the purpose of conducting a hearing and issuing a proposed decision in the instant matter; and the Commission having further provided in said Order that if neither party to the proceeding filed written objections to the Examiner's proposed decision and if the Commission did not act to set aside said proposed decision within twenty days from the date of the Examiner's decision, the proposed decision would be deemed to be the final decision of the Commission; and Examiner Knudson having, on April 22, 1980, issued his proposed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order Clarifying Bargaining Unit, with Accompanying Memorandum, pursuant to said Order; and no written objections having been filed and no Commission Order setting aside said proposed decision having been issued within the period provided;


