MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The parties agreed as follows:

In consideration for withdrawal of the prohibitive practice charge, the City of Wisconsin Rapids and Allen Spencer, Chief of Police, Wisconsin Rapids Police Department, will henceforth recognize the right of City Police Officers to union representation at any pre-discipline interviews or at any interview where the officer reasonably believes that any form of discipline may be imposed as a result of the interview and where the officer requests such representation.
