The Petitioner, Wesley A. Pederson, having moved to dismiss his petition for review on the grounds that he is no longer sheriff of Chippewa County, and therefore, this proceeding is moot as to him, and the Respondent, Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, having moved to dismiss its counter-petition for enforcement of its order on the grounds that current Chippewa County Sheriff Revoir has agreed to deputize Officers Robert Wanish and Daniel Prince for the exclusive purpose of attending certification school, the Respondent reserving the right to bring an enforcement action in the future should that become necessary, and the court having received no opposition on the merits of either motion by any party who has appeared of record,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that this proceeding is dismissed without costs.
